The route along the bank of the River Yare from Buckenham Mill drainage mill to the Broads Authority moorings at Cantley	21/08/14	21/02/15	There will be a phased closure for crest raising works at Buckenham and major repair works just downstream of Hassingham Fleet dyke. The works are expected to be completed by mid-November but the closure will remain in place over the winter. <i>NB The sections of bank either side of the works will remain accessible but there will be no through route.</i>
Carlton Colville and Barnby	28	Carlton Colville Footpaths 6 (part), FP5, FP3, FP2a and Barnby FP8, adjacent to Carlton Colville Marshes and the Suffolk Wildlife Nature Reserve and on the bank of the River Waveney.	05/07/14	06/01/15	There will be a phased closure of the route from Barnby Hundred sluice to Share Mill for crest raising works during the summer and autumn. A longer term closure will apply to a section of footpath and bridleway that links the Carlton Marshes visitor centre with the River Waveney. This is necessary due to the construction of a new bank at the base of Peto's Marsh. Signed alternative routes will be available including for those people using the Waveney River Centre passenger ferry.
